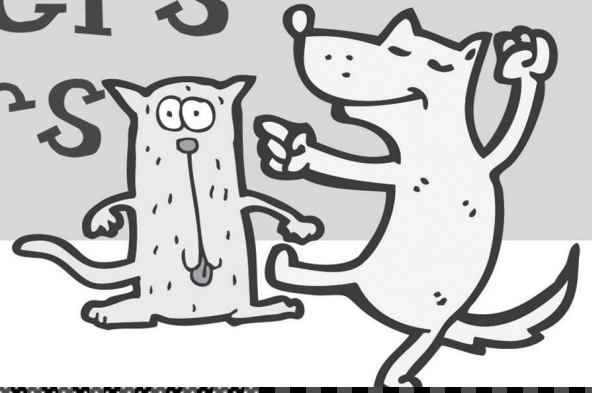

It's hard to believe that 18 years have come and gone. We have grown by leaps and bounds – from helping a few hundred pets a year to 34,300 in 2017! It's been an amazing, and at times trying, journey but a very rewarding one. We are very proud of our accomplishments, the services we now provide, and the number of pets that we are now able to keep out of shelters and in loving homes.

I am very grateful to all of you that have helped us to help all these pets. 2018 is not expected to much different than the past several years. We have a lot of new programs, services, and a new expanded location in Springfield on the horizon in 2018. None of this could have been accomplished without your support. Thank you for helping us to help so many.

Our new Worcester location is already very busy even though it has only been open for a few months. We are pleased to see so many people that have never been able to get to our veterinary hospital in North Brookfield now have access to veterinary services.

What's next? While we never really know all that will come up in 2018, we do know that we will be relocating our Springfield veterinary hospital to a larger facility. We quickly outgrew our leased space in Springfield and recently purchased a building to move this facility to. Thanks to a grant from PetSmart Charities, we will be able to renovate this building for expanded pet services. We also know that we will be increasing the number of pets we will be saving from shelters where they are at risk for being euthanized, from cruelty and neglect cases, and many other situations. Adoptions were up 70% in 2017 from 2016 with the first full year of our Almost Home facility. This facility was instrumental in our ability to help out during the hurricane disasters as well. We look forward to 2018 and helping more animals live better lives! Thank you for being a part of the Second Chance family!

NEW PROTOCOL GOES NATIONAL!

We are so proud of the accomplishments of Second Chance. Many of the things that are done behind the scenes to save lives and make them better are not always noticed. But one in particular has gained national attention.

If you have gone to a shelter in New England in the last couple of years you know that we (animal welfare in New England) have made great strides in ending pet overpopulation and unnecessary euthanasia of shelter pets. With that has come the ability to help each other out, and to extend our help beyond just Massachusetts to help prevent euthanasia. That means that we are able to take pets in from other shelters in New England and beyond when space here is available. As that has happened, there has been a huge struggle to reduce the stress of transporting pets, whether it is only a couple of hours or several hours from shelter to shelter. Stress, especially in cats, can cause them to become ill with upper respiratory infections. This can significantly increase their time at the shelter before they are able to be adopted, not to mention that the cat has to deal with being sick.

At Second Chance, we developed a simple yet extremely effective way to drastically reduce the stress of moving cats and thus reducing the incidence of illness. This protocol basically just keeps the change in environment to a minimum by transporting things that the cat is used to along with the cat. Normally, the cat is taken from a cage in one shelter, put in a carrier, then moved to another cage at the new shelter. New litter boxes, new dishes, new toys etc. To us humans that doesn't seem like a big thing, but to a cat it is a life changing adventure that is stressful. The new protocol has recently been written about in national magazines to shelters across the country to be able replicate the success. Maddie's Fund, a large funder of animal welfare, also had us do up a "flash class" which was taped and is now able to be viewed by shelters across the country as a learning tool for them. The ASPCA utilizes this transport for their cat transporting, as well as many others. Incidents of cat illness were reduced by as much as 70% utilizing this new protocol!



This is exciting for us to know that we are not only able to help the pets that come through our doors but across the country. The less time a cat has to wait to go to a new home the better. And, the quicker shelters can open up that cage for another pet in need. Everyone wins – especially the cats who have less stress and get to a forever home faster! This is one of many new developments initiated at Second Chance. More are underway that will help pets to live better, happier lives. Stay tuned!

NOTEABLE NARRATIVES

So many stories come through our doors every day, but we always like to share a few of the special ones with all of you!

Kitten seriously injured in barbed wire accident getting a Second Chance

Here is the story: Barely a day goes by when Second Chance doesn't see some kind of serious injury or other medical emergency at their veterinary clinics. But this little kitten's brush with death took many hands to help save him. When a good Samaritan saw this kitten hung up in a barbed wire fence, he came to Second Chance's Wellness Center in North Brookfield for help. This kitten was struggling with his arm completely wrapped in the barbed wire. Two veterinary technicians were able to cut the wire and bring the kitten, wires and all, back to the clinic.



Initial exam of the kitten showed a grave prognosis for saving the leg. It had been wrapped in the barbed wire for apparently some time and circulation had been cut off. The wire had pierced the skin in several areas as well. Immediately the cat was brought into surgery to remove the wire, insert a drain, and begin pain management and antibiotics to prevent infection.



The kitten, who was named "Freddy" took several weeks to heal. But thanks to an amazing medical staff, a loving foster home, donations for his care, and a loving home – Freddy's leg was not only saved but



he now has a loving forever home!

Lifesaving Times Three



Chloe came to us from an animal control facility. We were told that she was surrendered and had been pregnant and in labor for a few days. She was unable to deliver and the puppies were deceased inside so she needed emergency surgery. But when she arrived, a quick ultrasound at our veterinary hospital in North Brookfield showed that the puppies were not deceased! A race against time began since she had been in labor for days so the puppies were under a great deal of stress. They had to be delivered quickly and get imme-



diate care.

Our team went to work with great hope. We were so happy to have the ultrasound that alerted us to the ability to try and save these puts. In less than an hour, two pups were born. The next few days were touch and go. The amount of time mom was in labor was long and the risk to the pups was great. But days later, mom and pups were doing great in their foster home! Fortunately their foster mom was one of our experienced veterinary technicians and watched these little lives closely. Mom and pups thrived and all were recently adopted after 9 weeks in foster care!



Florida, Texas, Puerto Rico – OH MY!

For many of you that have followed our work for years, you know that we always help out in disasters, cruelty cases, and more. There is usually at least one a year. But this year was exceptional. We had THREE disasters to deal with all in the span of only a few weeks.



Texas was first. We all know the devastation there. When we found that a convoy of trucks was headed down to Texas with human supplies, we were able to organize a couple of truckloads of supplies for pets too. The trucks were loaded with food, toys, crates, and other supplies to help with the pets in need. We enjoyed partnering with Curt Schilling (yes the famous baseball player from the Red Sox!) who was one of the drivers to get the supplies down there.



Next came Florida. We were asked by the ASPCA to help with an airlift of 99 pets from shelters in FL. These were pets that were already in the shelters in the affected areas. They needed to be moved out so the shelters could recover and also to take in displaced pets there so the owners had time to get back on their feet.

In less than 24 hours, we were at the Hartford CT airport unloading 99 dogs and cats.

They arrived in two plane loads 24 hours apart. It was a large amount of pets to take in all at once.

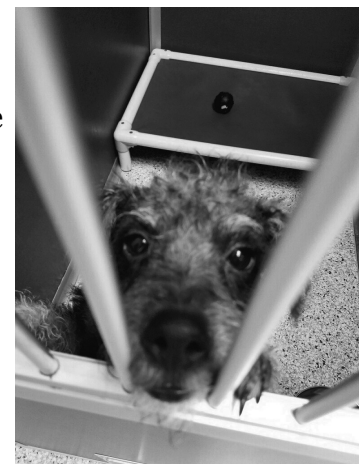
But the team of staff, volunteers and emergency volunteers came together. Many of these pets needed significant medical care and the cost was over \$40,000. to treat and care for these pets. Many of the pets that came from these shelters were pets that had been in the shelters down there for a while and were in desperate need of surgeries or other medical treatments. Over the course of the next few months the pets went to forever homes and we thought life was going to back to normal. But think again....

While we were still dealing with helping the Florida pets in our care, Puerto Rico was devastated. We were asked to take in another 21 pets through HSUS airlift from the island. We took these in as well and provide care and medical treatment. In all 120 pets came through us from these affected areas.

Puerto Rico was especially concerning to us as our sister shelter that we have been mentoring over the past year through our H.O.P.E. program was in the eye of the storm. Since the hurricane, communication has been tough but it is slowly getting better. We are hoping to resume our transport assistance with them soon.

In the meantime, two members of our staff, along with members from HSUS and University of Florida made their way to Puerto Rico in January. This trip was to help them get back up and running and provide them with additional hands on training to be able to do more. We were thrilled to make this trip and we are hoping that it will mean more lives being saved going forward. We will update all of you on this progress as time goes on.

While we hope we don't see the devastation that we saw in 2017 with these hurricanes, or the cases of cruelty that we assisted with as well, we will always work to help where help is needed. Thank you to everyone that helped to support these vital missions!





A Sad Setback for Second Chance



We are usually the ones stepping in during disasters to help out. But recently one was inside our own doors. We have been working to ready a new building in Springfield to move our existing community veterinary hospital in Springfield to. Things were going great. We had found a perfect building with lots of room for us to do our work, Petsmart Charities had provided us with a grant to get the building ready, and our staff was excited at having more space to help more pets.



In mid-January that changed. A roofer working on putting a new roof on the building. We had two days of downpours and water got in under the tarps. Our building sustained water damage in all 23 rooms.

Loss of ceilings, insulation, electrical and more set the project back.

As of the writing of this we are still assessing damage, working with insurance, and hoping that we will somehow be able to get back on track to open in early May. We are devastated by the damage but we know how important this hospital is to the pets in the Springfield area. We will get back on track soon we hope and back to saving the lives of pets in need. Until then, we will continue to use our present building and do as much as we can.

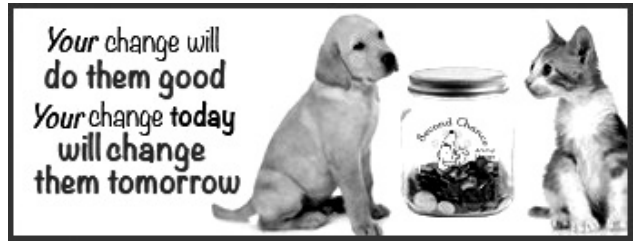
