## President’s Letter

It’s hard to believe, our 20th year of helping pets is upon us! A lot has changed in those 20 years – for us and for animal welfare. We have grown from a small adoption organization helping a few hundred pets a year to what we are today, helping over 37,000 pets a year! We now operate an adoption center, 2 satellite adoption centers, a transport holding facility, and 3 full service veterinary hospitals that serve the pets in the community. We are the ONLY animal welfare organization in MA that provides full service veterinary hospitals that not only serve all pet owners in the community but also offer subsidized rates for those that qualify so everyone has access to care. Animal welfare has also changed in the past 20 years. In the northeast spay/neuter has brought the overpopulation under control and is now continuing to maintain the population. Shelters around the region now see themselves with empty cages. There is no reason for anyone in this area to euthanize a healthy, adoptable pet. Times have changed for the better, for pets in the northeast. That is why Second Chance opened a transport facility to help pets in other areas that are still overcrowded with pets at risk.

There is still a LOT of work to be done which is why Second Chance changed to meet those needs. While 91% of the pets in the general population are spayed/neutered, 87% in underserved communities are not (stats from HSUS). We are out there in the community to help those pets.

There is also the work of providing access to care for all. In underserved communities 77% of pets have never seen a vet. This is not because their owners don’t love them, but simply because they can’t afford traditional veterinary costs and/or do not have the ability to easily get there. That is why we opened up our veterinary hospitals. Everyone is welcome to bring their pets to our highly skilled team of veterinarians and get the best care. For those that are on fixed incomes such as the elderly and disabled, we provide access to care with our subsidized rates. We are able to do this because all the funds generated by our hospitals go directly back to helping pets.

We are doing so much more too. We have developed procedures and protocols that have been embraced by other animal welfare organizations across the country. This includes our protocol for the best practices of transporting cats from one shelter to another. It sounds simple enough but cats stress easily in transport. We wanted to be able to help shelters where pets were being euthanized. Our protocol reduces stress related illnesses by 70%.

We have so many programs that are revolutionizing animal welfare and have afforded us the ability to help so many more pets than ever before. As we celebrate our 20th year we are extremely grateful to all of you that have joined in this journey and help to support our work so we can be there for pets whenever they need us. We can’t do this alone and we cannot thank you enough for being part of the Second Chance family as we celebrate 20 years of dramatic lifesaving growth! We look forward to a future where we can ensure that no pet goes without the services needed to live a healthy and happy long life.

# “More Than Just a Shelter” Programs That Help Pets Beyond Our Walls



When Second Chance was founded in 1999, our main objective was to find homes for a few stray pets. As we’ve grown through the past 20 years, so has the list of new ways we’ve found to help pets. Here are just some of the programs we could not provide without your continued support.

**Vaccine & Microchip Clinics:** We go out into the community with our low-cost vaccine & microchip clinics to ensure all pets have access to life-saving immunizations. Each of our hospitals also host a weekly walk-in clinic offering the same low-cost vaccines and microchips.

**Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Clinics:** Each of our hospitals offers low-cost spays and neuters, keeping pets healthier and helping to control the pet population.

**Full-Service Veterinary Hospitals offering Subsidized Rates:** Our hospitals are open to everyone, providing full-service veterinary care. We also offer subsidized rates for qualified households to ensure all pets have access to the medical care they need. We are the only animal welfare organization offering full-service veterinary care at subsidized rates in Massachusetts.

**Pet Food Pantry:** We found that many pet owners struggling to keep food on their own table will often go without for the sake of their pets so we established our pet food pantry to help. We provide food to 17 local food pantries to make sure no one goes hungry.

**Home Bound to the Rescue:** We also found that in addition to pet food, elderly need assistance with basic pet care during these tough economic times. Many of the elderly cannot afford to provide basic medical care for their pets and/or don’t have the transportation available to get their pets to a veterinarian. This program assists pet owners by providing the services right at their doorstep. By going to elderly housing areas, we are able to help the elderly to keep their pets healthy and up to date on vaccines.



**Foster Program:** Many pets come to Second Chance with medical needs. Just like people, pets heal faster at home, so we are grateful to our fosters who open their homes and their hearts to pets in need. By giving a temporary home to a homeless pet, you can save the life of an otherwise homeless pet. Foster care consists of providing a safe, loving, temporary home for a dog until a permanent adoptive home can be found. Fosters also help make room at the shelter so we can help even more pets. ## NOTEABLE NARRATIVES

So many stories come through our doors every day. We always like to share a few of the special ones with all of you!

### A Second Chance for Forrest



This is Forrest, one of the 37,400 pets we helped last year. Forrest is a three year old boxer mix who got his Second Chance when the shelter he was living at was out of space and he came to us on a transport. When our doctors examined this sweet boy, who loves to carry his toys around, they found evidence of an old jaw fracture that has thankfully healed. Blood tests revealed he is also positive for heartworm, a preventable but serious and sometimes fatal condition. The heartworm diagnosis could have made him a prime candidate for euthanasia at his former shelter. Forrest must complete his treatment before he can be adopted.

### Bastet Survives 3-Story Fall

Meet Bastet, a six month old kitten injured when she survived a 3 story fall. She came to Second Chance with a broken femur and no where else to turn. Our medical staff took in this sweet girl, stabilized her and operated to repair her femur.

Because she is so young, she had a very good prognosis. She was fostered by one of our vet techs for round the clock care and love while she healed and recently adopted!!



### Happy Ending for Little Elf

Little Elf is a puppy who came to Second Chance battling life threatening parvo. When no one else could help, Second Chance opened our doors to the pup and nursed him back to health. Little Elf is now with his forever family thanks to your support.

### In Memory of Abby FKA Patty



We were saddened to learn of the recent passing of Abby. Many will remember her as Patty, the young lab mix who came to Second Chance with a serious heart condition. She was diagnosed with a very serious condition called a Patent Ductus, a congenital defect Her heart could not pump blood normally the way it was meant to and after living with this condition for 3 years, this sweet little girl was now starting to show signs of heart failure.

Her amazing foster family, who opened their home and their hearts to this sweet girl as she went through medical treatment and would later adopt her, gave her so much love.
