## **President's Letter**

We did it! We reached another exciting milestone in 2019 – helping a record 40,000 pets. An exciting accomplishment for sure. We could not have done this without our supporters, an amazing and passionate staff and our loving dedicated volunteers. There is a saying that "it takes a village to raise a child". Well, it takes a lot of hands to give all these pets a second chance. Things are not always easy. We see things that are sometimes difficult and deeply tragic, but we pull together and make it happen.

We have been laser focused on trying to keep pets in their homes whenever possible and when it makes the most sense. This is being achieved through our ability to provide access to care and assistance to all pets. We provide subsidized rates at each of our veterinary hospitals for qualified households, providing access to high quality veterinary care regardless of income.



This year, 2020, we are embarking on our largest project yet. We made the **exciting announcement on Christmas that we are opening our 4**<sup>th</sup> **veterinary hospital in Southbridge** – but this is not just a veterinary hospital. This is a partnership with Bay Path Regional Vocational Technical High School to provide a veterinary science program for high school students. They will not only complete their secondary academic education but will be getting real-life experience working alongside our dedicated, trained staff, learning about working in the veterinary field. They will see what it's like to be a receptionist, a vet assistant, grooming and more, graduating with a certificate in veterinary assistance. Graduates can then go on to the workforce or pursue a veterinary technician or veterinarian degree.

Words cannot express our appreciation for all of our supporters who have helped us to change the face of animal welfare, no longer just focusing on pets in the shelter but addressing the root causes of animal suffering and helping to keep pets in homes when they have loving homes already. It is a new concept for animal welfare that is now catching on and keeping more pets safe, healthy and happy. Thank you for believing in us and we look forward to doing more for pets in the come year!

## Where Do Our Shelter Pets Come From?

The short answer is **everywhere**.

They come from pet owners who, for many reasons, can no longer care for them. Some are brought to us by a family member of someone that has passed away and left a pet behind with no one else who can take them in.

We also work with over 65 animal control officers and other shelters in Massachusetts. They bring us stray pets, surrendered pets, and pets with needs that they cannot address but know that Second Chance can handle. This includes medically needy pets. We have



made it our mission to give pets that would have been euthanized for medical issues a 'Second Chance." Our 3 full-service veterinary hospitals located around the state can provide care for medical issues at a lower cost. Relying on our own hospitals allows us to stretch every dollar donated so these **pets go from helpless to home**.

Another way pets come to us is through our animal relocation program. We opened our "**Almost Home**" transport facility in North Brookfield in 2015 to help pets from shelters across the country. These pets come to Almost Home from overcrowded facilities where the animals are at risk of being euthanized simply because they had run out of space. These pets undergo the mandatory state quarantine period of 48 hours at the facility, get their medical needs addressed, and are evaluated for any other needs as they begin their transition to a new home. Once cleared, they can go to the adoption center when space is available. This ensures that local pets remain a priority.



Second Chance is also a national emergency partner with national groups such as HSUS, ASPCA and others. When disaster strikes, Second Chance is on standby to help where needed and has been deployed to wherever the need is required. In recent years we have helped pets from hoarding, dog fighting, cruelty and abuse cases, sending trained staff to help care and evaluate these pets so that we can take in some in when they are released from custody. During natural disasters such as hurricanes and tornados, Second Chance has driven hundreds of miles to pick up pets from evacuated shelters and get them to safety here with Second Chance. Sometimes this means meeting planes that have flown pets out of the path of danger.

Second Chance continues to have **the lowest adoption fees in the state**, despite the cost of caring for these pets. While the average cost to provide assistance for the 40,000 pets that have sought help in 2019 through Second Chance programs and services is about \$100 per pet, the cost of getting a pet ready for adoption is often \$500 and can be \$1,000 or more for those with serious medical needs. We don't ever want to turn away a pet with treatable medical needs. We want to give them the chance they deserve.

## **Tucker's Rescue Story**

Tucker is a chihuahua mix born last summer. Tucker watched as, one by one, his siblings left with visitors. Soon he was the last puppy. One day, he found himself loaded into a box. Tucker was excited and thought maybe he was going where his siblings went. He missed the company of other dogs to play with.

Tucker's owner tried to find a home for Tucker but had no luck. Overwhelmed and unsure of what to do, the owner put Tucker in a box and brought him to a dumpster.

Tucker's luck changed that day because a concerned citizen saw what was about to happen and confronted the owner. They rescued Tucker that day and brought him home. Tucker got along great with the rescuer's dog. They would have kept him, but they knew they didn't have time for a young dog. It wouldn't be fair!

They brought Tucker to Second Chance. They knew what they wished his owner knew - that Second Chance would

take in this young pup, tend to his vaccines and any medical needs and get him ready for adoption.

Second Chance Animal Services provides many services to help keep pets in their homes, from vaccine and spay/neuter clinics, to a pet food pantry, to subsidized rates for veterinary care at our hospitals. But we know that sometimes people need to surrender their pets and that's where our adoption center comes in. Owners unable to keep their pet can call 508-867-5525 to make arrangements to keep their pet safe and cared for.

Tucker found his forever family soon after arriving at our adoption center in East Brookfield. Your continued support makes happy endings like this possible. Thank you!

### Monthly Pet Pal Champions Make A Difference All Year Long You can change the lives of many pets in need.

- 50¢ per day (\$15/month) can provide vaccines and flea treatment for a shelter pet.
- \*\* \$1 per day (\$30/month) can provide spay/neuter surgeries for 10 dogs and cats, reducing the number of homeless pets in our community.
- \$2 per day (\$60/month) can provide subsidized veterinary care to 5 dogs and cats, ensuring that people on fixed incomes do not have to surrender their beloved pets because they can't cover veterinary costs.
